

The 2016 Summer Reading Program ended on Wednesday, August 3rd. A total of 1,308 children participated in our programs. We had 145 children

register to read during the 6 week period. A total of 2,109 books were read and 153,857 pages. Congratulations to all the children that read for book bucks. We need support from the community for our extensive summer programs. Donations toward these programs are greatly appreciated.
